## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR

## MINI "C" ARM FLOOR LAMP

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- \*This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce risk of electric shock. \*This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If it does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician.
- \*Never use with an extension cord unless the plug can be fully inserted.
- \*DO NOT ALTER THE PLUG.
- \*Turn the power off (remove electrical plug from outlet) before replacing light bulb, making sure the bulb has cooled.
- \*Do not subject the lamp to any shock while lit as shattering of bulb may result.

## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:**

NOTE: Do not connect the electricity until lamp is fully assembled.

- 1. Remove all parts from carton. Do not throw away any parts.
- 2. Place the lamp base on a soft (carpeted), level surface.
- 3. Use wrench (E) to unthread and remove screws (C) and washers (A) from the bottom of column (B).
- 4. Align column (B) with the back of base (D).
- 5. Slip washers (A) over screws (C). Guide screws and washers into the threaded holes in the bottom of base (D) and into column (B).
- 6. Tighten screws (C) with wrench (E).
- 7. Remove finial (F) from harp (H).
- 8. Squeeze harp (H) inward and place into the opening of saddle (I).
- 9. Place shade (G) onto harp (H). Place diffuser (J) on top of shade (G).
- 10. Screw finial (F) onto harp (H) to secure the shade and diffuser to the lamp.
- 11. Insert one (1) 100W MAX. Type A, medium base bulb into the socket.
- 12. Remove protective plastic (G) from polarized plug (F). Insert polarized plug (F) into wall outlet.
- \* To clean, use a soft cloth only. Do not use any chemical or abrasive cleaners.
